### Plateau I

The project revolves around the pedagogical activities of Miha Vipotnik, a pioneer Slovenian video artist who joined the Department of Film and Television in 2002. Slovenian-Lebanese duo are cocurating an exhibition by putting on display documentation, video-works, sketches, and relics from various workshops organized by Vipotnik during his teaching career in Lebanon.





### Plateau II

The exhibition is based on Emile Hannouche's art collection, which Vipotnik sees as a starting point for contemporary interdisciplinary, and transmedia art program. The project involves digitalizing the collection and using it in cultural initiatives. By curating this exhibition with his students, we explored both its educational value and how specific art media evolve alongside technological advancements.
